



## ESKER DELIVERS DOCUMENT CONTROL WITH FAX ON DEMAND FOR MAJOR AUSTRALIAN ROAD DEVELOPMENT

Thiess John Holland, has been awarded the contract for Australia's largest urban road development, Melbourne's EastLink motorway which joins Mitcham and Frankston. With more than 2,000 people working on the project and seven major regional offices plus site offices, Thiess John Holland found traditional fax communications inefficient and untenable. The company turned to Esker's Fax on Demand to automate production faxing and business processes.

### The business challenge

With the commencement of the EastLink Project in November 2004, Thiess John Holland realised, because of the sheer size and scale of the project, maintaining control of the document process was going to be a challenge.



The scale of the project has definitely been one of the biggest business challenges. The EastLink Project is the largest civil project of its type in Australia to date with more than 650 users. We identified at the outset the need for a system that would both automate and control the fax process so communication between designers, regional offices and site officers was efficient and accurate.

### Specific Issues faced

Thiess John Holland was clear that it wanted a complete document control solution to cater for all the incoming and outbound faxes, specifically:

- Capture of all incoming faxes
- Capture of **all outbound faxes**
- **Compatibility** with Microsoft Exchange and Outlook
- **Integration with existing Thiess IT systems** including ERP JD Edwards
- **An out of the box solution** that required no building or implementing of infrastructure
- **Fast implementation** within two and half weeks
